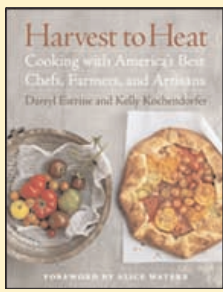
## What's New at the Library?
