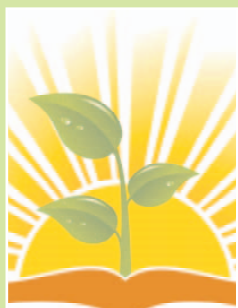

Babies Boogie

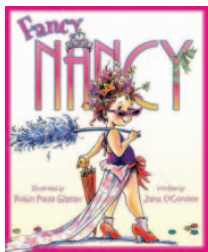
