WHEREAS, the New York Health and Essential Rights Act, as codified in New York Labor Law §§ 218-b and 27-d (the "NY HERO Act"), establishes new requirements for preventing employee exposure to certain airborne infectious diseases; and

WHEREAS, the NY HERO Act permits employers and unions to waive the Act's requirements in a collective bargaining agreement, provided that the waiver explicitly references the NY HERO Act's section(s) that are being waived, and the Board of Trustees has reviewed the MOA dated September 8, 2021 between WLSA and the Library, RESOLVED that the MOA dated September 8, 2021 between WLSA and the Library regarding the HERO Act is hereby ratified
