

Please note the tax levy limit for the year 2018-19 from the Office of the State Comptroller is \$2,285,734 for the Westhampton Free Library. The proposed levy is \$2,258,392 for the 2018-19 year for the Westhampton Free Library. The proposed levy is below the tax cap levy limit by \$27,342. The levy limit is composed of the tax base growth factor of 1.0000 and the allowable levy growth factor of 1.0200 for a total allowable levy increase of \$44,977 to remain under the tax cap.*

In addition, please note that budget reflects a prepayment of \$1,102,820 on the debt service anticipated in June 2019
